28	Smoking by employees at state mental health institutes is governed by section 1580-A.
30	Further amend the bill by inserting after the emergency clause and before the statement of fact the following:

16	health institute may smoke in a designated smoking area that must be enclosed and adequately ventilated. Smoking by employees at state mental health institutes would be governed by the Workplace
