COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1373, L.D. 1904, Bill, "An Act to Increase Fees for Defensive Driving Courses"

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Enactment of this legislation would result in:

1. An increase in Other Special Revenue to the Department of Public Safety, Defensive Driving - Bureau of Safety, Acct. #04650.7, in the amount of \$24,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This

2 increase in dedicated revenue would be derived from the proposed
increased of \$5 in the defensive driving course fee; and

Defensive Driving - Bureau of Safety, Acct. #04650.7, in the
6 amount of \$24,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This allocation would
provide funds for additional staff time costs and related
