An Act to Increase Fees for Defensive Driving Courses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 MRSA §4208, as amended by PL 1981, c. 292, is further amended to read: 4

§4208. Defensive driving courses; fees

and the second The Department of Public Safety is authorized to conduct defensive driving courses for the purpose of promoting highway safety and to charge a registration fee of \$15 \$20 to 10 participants in the defensive driving courses conducted under the auspices of the department. The fee shall be used to cover the 12 cost of conducting the courses. Any balances remaining at the end 14 of the fiscal year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to be used for the purposes stated in this section. 16

STATEMENT OF FACT

The number of defensive driving courses and the cost of conducting the courses is increasing substantially. Additional 22 revenues are needed to cover the cost of the program. Student fees are the only source of revenue to cover program operations. 24 This bill will increase fees for defensive driving courses. 26
