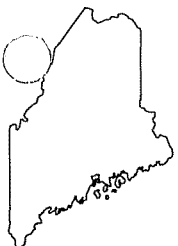

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act Modifying the Territory of the Northport Village Corporation.

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, The purpose of this legislation is to transfer
property that is located within the territorial limits of
Northport Village Corporation to the Town of Northport; and

Whereas, certain residents within the territorial limits of
Northport Village Corporation no longer desire to be included
within the territorial limits of Northport Village Corporation;
and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1915, c. 136, §1-A is enacted to read:

Section 1-A. Notwithstanding section 1, all that portion of
land located westerly of the Bluff Road is no longer a part of
the Northport Village Corporation.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the boundaries of the Northport Village
Corporation and transfers a portion of the corporation's
territory to the Town of Northport.
