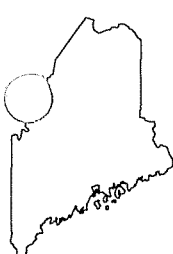

8                                   **STATEMENT OF FACT**

10           Under current law, the Joint Standing Committee on Labor is  
12           required to review, before March 15, 1990, the provisions  
14           governing family medical leave requirements. Current law also  
          repeals those family medical leave requirements, effective July  
          1, 1990. This bill repeals the sunset and review requirements.
