An Act to Adjust Commercial Motor Vehicle Fees.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §246-A, sub-§3**, as amended by PL 1985, c. 812, Pt. A, §3, is further amended to read:

6 **3. Form of application.** Application shall be made upon a form and in a manner prescribed by the Secretary of State and shall set forth such information as the Secretary of State may require. The application shall be accompanied by a fee of \$15 \$7.50 for each vehicle listed in the application licensed. On and after October 1st, the fee shall be 1/2 rate.

12 **Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act shall take effect January 1, 1991.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 The purpose of this bill is to adjust the fuel use identification decal fee from \$15 to \$7.50.
