An Act to Abate Nonpoint Source Pollution from Road Runoff.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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23 MRSA §707 is enacted to read:

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§707. Nonpoint source pollution

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The Department of Transportation and the Department of Environmental Protection shall jointly adopt standards for using constructed wetlands, for the control of nonpoint source pollution from road runoff, for all new roads and all reconstructions and expansions of existing roads within the State.
