An Act to Allow Medical Testing without Physician Referral.

_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	22 MRSA §2013-A, sub-§1, ¶G, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 456,
4	§2, is amended to read:
6	G. Laboratory services performing health screening tests as defined and regulated by rule adopted by the department and
8	the commission. <u>Services exempted under this paragaph</u> include, but are not limited to, the performance of the

14	<u>(a) Urinalysis, including microscopic evaluation;</u> or

44	STATEMENT OF FACT
46	This bill amends the law giving the Maine Medical Laboratory Commission rule-making authority to allow medical testing without
48	referral by a physician. The commission, contrary to legislative
50	intent, is currently allowing only one type of test. This bill provides further guidance to the commission by listing the tests that may be performed without referral by a physician.
