IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Fund Sex Offender Treatment in Maine's Correctional Facilities.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, the State's sex offender program has recently terminated due to lack of funding; and 6 8 Whereas, a growing percentage of prison inmates are sex offenders; and 10 Whereas, it is in the State's best interest to do all that 12 is possible to reduce repeat sex offenses and treatment has proven to be one mechanism for reducing recidivism; and 14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 16 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 18 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, 20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 22 Appropriation.
