SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 733, L.D. 1932, Bill, "An Act to Promote and Assist Barrier-free Construction in Places of Public Accomodation and Places of Employment"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S4594-D~~" in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "January 1, 1991." the following: 'when the total estimated costs for enlarging an existing building exceed \$100,000.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the law applies to enlargements of existing buildings when the cost of the enlargement exceeds \$100,000.
