**An Act to Provide Access to Preventive Dental Care Services to Adults
Eligible for Medicaid.**



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1.** 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1989, c.
502, Pt. A, §72, is repealed.

6 **Sec. 2.** 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

8 1-A. Coverage provided. The Department of Human Services
9 shall provide preventive, diagnostic and corrective dental
10 services, reimbursed under the United States Social Security Act,
11 Title XIX, or successors to it, to individuals 21 years of age
12 and over, including treatment of:

14 A. The teeth and associated structures of the oral cavity;
15 and

16 B. Disease, injury or impairment that may affect the oral
17 or general health of the recipient.

18 **Sec. 3.** 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1989, c.
19 502, Pt. A, §72, is repealed.
