HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 746,
L.D. 1950, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Annexation of Land
Adjacent to the Town of East Millinocket"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the
following:

'Further amend the bill in section 2 in the first paragraph
in the 5th line (page 1, line 44 in L.D.) by inserting after the
word "Act" the following: 'for the purposes of voting on the
annexation described in section 1, and at the 2nd regular
municipal election after passage of this Act for the purposes of
voting on the annexation described in section 2'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the 4th
indented paragraph before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the
following:

**'Sec. 3. Planning costs to be absorbed by the Town of East
Millinocket.** All costs associated with the transfer of
jurisdiction over lands in Township A, Range 7 WELS from the
Maine Land Use Regulation Commission to the Town of East
Millinocket must be borne by the Town of East Millinocket.'

Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking
out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the
following:

'If either annexation outlined in this Act is approved by
the voters, all costs associated with the transfer of
jurisdiction over lands in Township A, Range 7 WELS from the
Maine Land Use Regulation Commission to the Town of East
Millinocket will be borne by the Town of East Millinocket.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes separate elections for voting on the annexation of the 2 parcels of land by the Town of East Millinocket. It also requires the Town of East Millinocket to bear all the costs associated with transfer and amends the fiscal note accordingly.
