**An Act to Improve the Staffing, Funding and Land Acquisition
Process of the Land for Maine's Future Board.**



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §6206-A, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989,
c. 603, §1 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 **§6206-A Nominations**

8 The board may not consider any nomination for proposed
10 acquisition unless the owner or owners of the land in the
proposed acquisition make the nomination.

12 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated
14 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
