COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1411, L.D. 1963, Bill, "An Act Requiring the State to Pay a Portion of the Health Insurance Premium for Dependents of Retired State Employees"

Amend the bill in the first line after the amending clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in subsection 8 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "60%" and inserting in its place the following: '10%'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
