IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act Requiring the State to Pay a Portion of the Health Insurance Premium for Dependents of Retired State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 5 MRSA §285, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 391, §§4 and 4 7, is amended to read: 6 8. Fayment by Maine State Retirement System. The Maine State Retirement System shall pay 100% of only the retiree's 8 share and 60% of the retiree's dependent's share of the premiums for this insurance for persons who were previously eligible for this insurance pursuant to subsection 1, paragraph A and who have 10 subsequently become eligible pursuant to subsection 1, 12 paragraph G. 14 STATEMENT OF FACT 16 J.8 This bill requires the State to pay 60% of the health

20 employees. Currently, the State pays 100% of the premium for state employees and retirees but, with the exception of
