COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1414, L.D. 1966, "Resolve,
to Set Aside Space for a Memorial for Firefighters"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title
and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the
following:

Memorial for firefighters; space reserved. Resolved: That space
be reserved in the State House Complex to erect a memorial to
commemorate past and future firefighters who give their lives in
the line of duty. The location selected must be mutually agreed
upon among the Special Committee on the New Capitol Area Master
Plan, the State House and Capitol Park Commission and the Maine
Fire Chiefs' Association. In the event that the Special
Committee on the New Capitol Area Master Plan is not able to
agree to a location by January 1, 1991, the location may be
mutually agreed upon between the State House and Capitol Park
Commission and the Maine Fire Chiefs' Association. For the
purposes of this resolve, "State House Complex" means the State
House and the immediate grounds as described in the Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 3, section 902-A.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the memorial for firefighters to
commemorate all past and future firefighters who give their lives
in the line of duty and adds the requirement that the location of
the memorial also be agreed upon by the Special Committee on the
New Capitol Area Master Plan. It further amends the bill by
allowing the location to be agreed upon by the State House and
Capitol Park Commission and the Maine Fire Chiefs' Association in
the event that the Special Committee on the New Capitol Area
Master Plan is not able to agree on a location by January 1, 1991.
