Resolve, to Set Aside Space for a Memorial for Firefighters.



Memorial for firefighters; space reserved. Resolved: That space

be reserved in the State House Complex to erect a memorial to
commemorate firefighters who have died in the line of duty. The

location selected must be mutually agreed upon between the State
House and Capitol Park Commission and the Maine Fire Chiefs'

Association. For the purposes of this resolve, "State House
Complex" means the State House and the immediate grounds as

described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 902-A.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve requires the State to set aside space in the State House Complex for a memorial to firefighters who have died in the line of duty.
