Resolve, to Set Aside Space for a Memorial for Firefighters.



2 **Memorial for firefighters; space reserved. Resolved:** That space
3 be reserved in the State House Complex to erect a memorial to
4 commemorate firefighters who have died in the line of duty. The
5 location selected must be mutually agreed upon between the State
6 House and Capitol Park Commission and the Maine Fire Chiefs'
7 Association. For the purposes of this resolve, "State House
8 Complex" means the State House and the immediate grounds as
 described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 902-A.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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 This resolve requires the State to set aside space in the
15 State House Complex for a memorial to firefighters who have died
16 in the line of duty.
