HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1423, L.D. 1975, Bill, "An Act to Protect Consumers Against Unsolicited Telefacsimile Transmissions"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in that part designated "§1496." in subsection 1 in paragraph A, in the last line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "conversion into" and inserting in its place the following: 'immediate direct printing as' '

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment in the last paragraph before the statement of fact in the next to the last line (page 1, line 38 in amendment) by striking out the following: "prima facie evidence of"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the definition of "telefacsimile transmission" to conform to the common understanding of "fax."
