HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 761,
L.D. 1986, Bill, "An Act Concerning Public Utilities"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title in
the next to the last line (page 1, line 25 in amendment) by
inserting after the following: "transmission line" the
following: 'that serves a substantial portion of the State'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd
paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 6 in the
4th line from the end (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting
after the following: "section 438-A" the following: '; provided
such approval does not affect municipal authority under these
sections' '

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph after the
title in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 31 and 32 in
amendment) by striking out the following: "**pursuant to the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4352, subsection 4**"

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph after the
title in the 7th line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by inserting
after the following: "subsection 4" the following: '; and rules
for the scope of prior approval established under this Act'

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph after the
title by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 39
to 42 in amendment).

6 This amendment clarifies the scope and effect of allowing
the Public Utilities Commission to approve electrical
transmission lines before municipal approval. It also provides
8 for commission rulemaking on this issue.
