HOUSE AMENDMENT "^B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 769,
L.D. 1994, Bill, "An Act to Provide for a Job Development
Training Funding Capability within the Resources of the State
Contingent Account"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place
the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the first line (page
1, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Sec. 2."

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5-A in the
2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 50 and 51 in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "~~sum sums~~" and inserting in its place the
following: 'sum'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5-A in the
3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 51 and 52 in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "~~\$1,000,000 \$1,075,000 in the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1990, and \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year
thereafter~~" and inserting in its place the following: '\$1,000,000'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5-A in the
8th line (page 2, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the
following: "industries." the following: 'In fiscal year 1989-90
\$75,000 of this amount may also be allocated for immediate job
training, unemployment counseling, retraining and other
assistance to displaced workers. In fiscal year 1989-90, an
additional \$75,000 of this amount may also be allocated for
immediate job training, unemployment counseling, retraining and
other assistance to displaced workers in the mid-coast area of
the State.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This amendment allows \$75,000 from the existing State
6 Contingent Account to be used in fiscal year 1989-90 for
7 immediate job training, unemployment counseling, retraining and
8 other assistance to workers displaced by Great Northern Paper
9 Company. This amendment also allows an additional \$75,000 from
10 the existing State Contingent Account to be used in fiscal year
11 1989-90 for job training and assistance to displaced workers in
12 the mid-coast area.
