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This bill specifies that, if additional funds are necessary because of local audit reports received after December 15th when next year's funding level must be certified by the State Board of Education, those funds will be provided by the Legislature. The bill allows the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services discretion regarding whether the subsidy should be withheld.
