An Act Concerning the Composition of the Advisory Council to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA \$7033, sub-\$1, as amended by PL 1989, c. 503, Pt. B, \$64, is further amended to read:

1. Appointment. The advisory council, established by Title 6 5, section 12004-G, subsection 20, shall consist of ene-member 8 representing -- each -- of -- the -- management -- units -- the -- commissioner establishes-to-administer-chapters-701-to-721 10 members. The 10 membership of the council must be apportioned such that all members represent comparable numbers of citizens. Members of the advisory council shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to 12 review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having 14 jurisdiction over fisheries and wildlife matters and to confirmation by the Legislature. The commissioner shall be a 16 nonvoting member of the council ex officio, but may vote to break a tie.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the membership of the advisory council to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The bill also reapportions the membership to achieve more equal statewide representation.
