SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1438, L.D. 2008, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Watershed District Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§2021." in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the last line (page 1, line 49 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§2021." in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the last line (page 1, line 54 in amendment) by striking out the following: "district." and inserting in its place the following: 'district; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§2021." in subsection 2 by inserting after paragraph D the following:

'E. The costs of any public hearing held by the department pursuant to section 2002, subsection 3, must be borne by the applicants.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 2. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

6 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the  
7 fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

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#### FISCAL NOTE

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Enactment of this legislation will result in:

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15 1. An increase in dedicated revenue to the Department of  
16 Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Quality Control, in the  
17 amount of \$1,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This increase in  
18 revenue will be derived from the requirement that the applicant  
19 pay the Department of Environmental Protection for the public  
20 hearing costs.

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23 2. An allocation of Other Special Revenue to the Department  
24 of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Quality Control, in  
25 the amount of \$1,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This allocation  
26 will provide funds for expected public hearing costs.'

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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33 This amendment requires that the costs of any public hearing  
34 held by the Department of Environmental Protection to discuss the  
35 formation of a coastal watershed district be paid by the  
36 applicants. The amendment also replaces the appropriation with  
37 an allocation and adds a new fiscal note.
