SENATE AMENDMENT " ^A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1438, L.D, 2008

Provides funds for anticipated public hearing costs associated with the formation of a coastal watershed district.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this legislation will result in:

 An increase in dedicated revenue to the Department of
 Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Quality Control, in the amount of \$1,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This increase in
 revenue will be derived from the requirement that the applicant pay the Department of Environmental Protection for the public
 hearing costs.

2. An allocation of Other Special Revenue to the Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Quality Control, in
24 the amount of \$1,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This allocation will provide funds for expected public hearing costs.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the costs of any public hearing held by the Department of Environmental Protection to discuss the formation of a coastal watershed district be paid by the applicants. The amendment also replaces the appropriation with an allocation and adds a new fiscal note.
