An Act to Provide Effective Follow-up for Wilderness Programs Required of Adjudicated Youth.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Approximately 10 students, 5 restitution participants and 5 youth-at-risk, will be in the full 28 Outward Bound program and a full year of follow-up with Community Service Project of Rockland. The bill also provides for 30 evaluation of the combined program.
