Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

38 MRSA §423-C is enacted to read:

5 §423-C. Operation of houseboats on inland waters

7 Houseboats may not be operated for more than 120 consecutive
8 days on any inland body of water that is used as or connected to
9 a body of water that is used as a public drinking water supply.
10 For purposes of this section, "houseboat" means a boat intended
11 for or used as a residence.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15
16 This bill prohibits the operation of houseboats for periods
17 in excess of 120 consecutive days on inland bodies of water that
18 are used as or connected to public drinking water supplies.
