## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

Resolve, to Establish the Commission to Study the Harness Racing Industry .

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, it is necessary that this legislation be enacted as an emergency measure in order that the commission may complete its study and that any recommendations may be implemented in a timely manner; and

10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts. create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 12 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, 14

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16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Commission established. Resolved: That the Commission 18 to Study the Harness Racing Industry is established; and be it 20 further

Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved: That the commission 22 shall consist of the following members: 2 members representing 24 the Harness Racing Commission; one member representing the Maine State Fair Association; one member representing Scarborough Downs; one member representing Lewiston Raceway; one member 26 representing the Maine Harness Horsemen's Association; one member 28 representing the Standard Bred Breeders Association; and one member representing the public. The Governor shall appoint all the members from a list of nominations provided to the Governor 30 by the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources; and 32 be it further

3. Sec. Appointments: meetings. **Resolved:** 34 That a11 appointments shall be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. The Commissioner of Agriculture, 36 Food and Rural Resources shall be notified by the Governor once 38 the selections have been made. The commissioner shall call the first meeting of the commission. The commission shall select a chair from its membership; and be it further 40

Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall undertake 42 a study of the harness racing industry with a goal of ensuring the integrity of that industry. As part of this study the 44 commission shall:

1. Determine whether the harness racing industry is a 48 viable industry and the amount of income, if any, it produces to the State;

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Develop improved methods of drug testing and oversight
 of drug use in the industry;

- 3. Examine the laws and rules governing the industry with a goal of establishing better enforcement mechanisms for violations of the laws or rules; and
- 8 4. Examine adequacy of current fee structures in the industry; and be it further

Sec. 5. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature by December 14 1, 1990; and be it further

16 Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the commission shall request from the Legislative Council sufficient staff assistance to carry out these duties; and be it further

Sec. 7. Reimbursement. Resolved: That all members of the commission who are not state employees be reimbursed for
 expenses, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 12002, upon application to the Department of Agriculture,
 Food and Rural Resources for those expenses; and be it further

Sec. 8. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

48 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This resolve establishes the Commission to Study the Harness Racing Industry. The commission will examine at the viability of 6 the industry, means to improve oversight of drug use in the industry, current fee schedules and enforcement mechanisms. The 8 commission will make its report, including any necessary implementing legislation, by December 1, 1990.

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
