L.D. 2033, Bill, "An Act to Allow State Employees and Teachers to  
Buy Back Time Spent as Peace Corps Volunteers"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated  
"§17764." in the 9th line (page 1, line 44 in amendment) by  
inserting after the following: "conditions." the following: 'For  
the purposes of this section "members" means state employees and  
teachers.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 3 in  
the 2nd line (page 2, line 10 in amendment) by inserting after  
the underlined word "State" the following: 'as state employees or  
teachers'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 4 in  
the 3rd line (page 2, line 16 in amendment) by inserting after  
the following: "payment" the following: 'or annual direct  
payments'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 4 in  
the last line (page 2, line 20 in amendment) by inserting after  
the following: "service." the following: 'Payments must be made  
as provided in section 17701.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that committee amendment "A" only  
applies to state employees and teachers. It also provides that  
the service credit authorized by committee amendment A may be
