An Act to Appropriate Funds for the Acquisition of Land in the Town of Enfield.

(EMERGENCY)



2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

4 Whereas, the purpose of this bill is to appropriate funds
6 for the acquisition of land that is to be kept free from
development; and

8 Whereas, it is in the best interest of the State to act as
10 quickly as possible on the purchase of this property; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety; now, therefore,

18 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

20 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from
the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
