An Act Concerning Violations Occurring in Watershed Districts.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 38 MRSA §2012 is enacted to read:

6 §2012. Fines returned to district

8 Any forfeiture, fine or other monetary penalty assessed by
10 the Department of Environmental Protection or the Board of
12 Environmental Protection for a violation related to a watershed
14 must be paid to the watershed district, if any, in which the
16 violation occurred.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill requires that forfeitures, fines or other monetary
22 penalties levied by the Department of Environmental Protection or
the Board of Environmental Protection for any reason against an
offender within a watershed district must be returned to the
watershed district in which the violation occurred.
