HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1462, L.D. 2039, Bill, "An Act to Protect Public Health by Prohibiting Smoking on Public Transportation Buses"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Protect Public Health by Requiring Proper Ventilation on Public Transportation Buses'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'22 MRSA §1580-C is enacted to read:

§1580-C. Proper ventilation on public transportation buses required

1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

A. "Bus" means every motor vehicle designed to carry more than 15 people, including passengers and the operator, and used for the transportation of passengers. "Bus" includes a chartered bus.
