28	STATEMENT OF FACT

32	This amendment strikes the entire committee amendment. This amendment seeks to protect the public health by requiring owners
34	or operators of all buses, including chartered buses, to provide a system to ensure adequate air ventilation in buses. The
36	amendment requires owners or operators to provide a smoking section on each bus for cigarette smoking and to conspicuously
38	post a notice in any area in which smoking is not permitted.
