SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 801,  
L.D. 2049, Bill, "An Act to Make Revisions in the Drug Testing  
Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of  
subsection 8 (page 2, lines 17 to 26 in amendment) and inserting  
in its place the following:

'8. Federal law; exceptions. This subchapter does not  
apply to the extent it is preempted by any federal law, rule or  
regulation. This subchapter does not apply in any way to:


A. Nuclear electrical generating facilities and their  
employees, including independent contractors and employees  
of independent contractors who are working at nuclear  
electrical generating facilities; or

B. Employers subject to regulations promulgated by the  
United States Department of Transportation and to any United  
States Department of Transportation rules or regulations  
that have been adopted as rules by this State's Department  
of Transportation.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment excludes employers that operate under the  
United States Department of Transportation regulations from  
coverage under this bill.
