STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Clarify the Relationship Between the Maine Potato Board, the Maine Potato Quality Control Board and the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §1033, sub-§3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 99, §11, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

3. Finances. The Maine Potato Board may receive funds
jointly from any source and spend funds in furtherance of this article, in accordance with the plan and budget proposed and
prepared by the Maine Potato Quality Control Board and the Maine
Potato Board and approved by the commissioner. The plan and
budget must be fashioned in a manner appropriate for the effective promotion of tablestock potatoes. Any funds received
by the Maine Potato Board shall be placed in a nonlapsing revolving fund.

Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §1033, sub-§4, as repealed and replaced by PL 18 1987, c. 99, §12, is amended to read:

20 Relationship to Maine Potato Board. The Maine Potato 4. Quality Control Board shall function under the oversight of the Maine Potato Board. The Maine Potato Quality Control Board and 22 the Maine Potato Board shall jointly annually prepare a plan and budget for the earrying-out-of-its--responsibilities-under-this 24 article, -- shall--submit--the--plan--and-budget--to--the-Maine--Potate 26 Board-for-its-approval-and,-following-approval,-shall-carry-out the--approved--plan effective promotion of tablestock potatoes which shall be submitted to the commissioner for approval. The 28 Maine Potato Quality Board shall carry out the approved plan. If 30 the plan and budget include the hiring of any staff, that staff shall be employees of the Maine Potato Board, in accordance with Title 36, section 4603, subsection 9. 32

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, the Maine Potato Quality Control Board submits a 38 plan of work and a proposal budget to the Maine Potato Board for The Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural approval. Resources, however, by virtue of Public Law 1987, chapter 99, 40 holds the entire operating budget of the Maine Potato Quality Control Board and makes it available through a grant to the Maine 42 Potato Board. This bill makes clear that the Maine Potato Quality Control Board and the Maine Potato Board shall jointly 44 prepare and submit a plan of work and budget to the commissioner 46 for approval as a condition to funds being made available.
