**An Act to Require Telecommunications Services in Public Places for
Hearing Impaired Persons.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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35-A MRSA §7505, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

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6. Relief. A violation of this section is unlawful public accommodations discrimination under Title 5, section 4592, and any person aggrieved may assert that person's rights pursuant to Title 5, chapter 337.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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Current law requires telecommunication devices for hearing and speech impaired persons in certain places of public accommodation. This bill provides for enforcement and relief for persons aggrieved by noncompliance.

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
