COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1491, L.D. 2064, Bill, "An Act Concerning Reimbursement to Municipalities for Property Taxes Lost Due to the Classification of Property in Farmland and Open Space Programs"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other \$250,000

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact of this bill is \$250,000 in fiscal year 1990-91. This amount could change in the future depending on the number of acres classified as farmland or open space.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill. It also adds an emergency clause.
