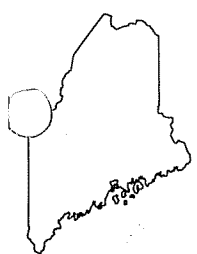

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**An Act to Remove Service-connected Disability Compensation from  
Income Calculations for Circuit Breaker Property Tax Relief.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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36 MRSA §6201, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 516, §§3  
and 6, is amended to read:

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7. **Household income.** "Household income" means all income,  
except for veteran's service-connected disability compensation,  
received by all persons of a household in a calendar year while  
members of the household.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill removes service-connected disability compensation  
from the computation of income for purposes of circuit breaker  
property tax relief.
