SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.  
805, L.D. 2068, Bill, "An Act Relating to Services to Infants and  
Young Children, Ages 0 through 5, Who Are Handicapped or at Risk  
for Developmental Delay"

Amend the amendment in section 11 in subsection 1 in the  
last line (page 5, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the  
following: "services." and inserting in its place the  
following: 'services;'

Further amend the amendment in section 11 in subsection 2 in  
the 2nd line (page 5, line 12 in amendment) by inserting after  
the following: "children" the following: ', ages 3 through 5,'

Further amend the amendment in section 11 in subsection 2 in  
subparagraph (17) in the first line (page 5, line 52 in  
amendment) by striking out the following: "governance." and  
inserting in its place the following: 'governance; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 11 by striking out  
all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Insurer or 3rd-party obligation. Nothing in this  
chapter relieves an insurer or similar 3rd party from an  
otherwise valid obligation to provide or pay for services  
provided.'

Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking  
out all of the last paragraph (page 7, lines 28 to 37 in  
amendment)

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes language requiring special education services in addition to those presently required by federal law so that state law requires only those services mandated by federal law. It also amends the fiscal note.
