An Act to Exempt Residential Developments from Noise Control Provisions.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §482-A, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 346,
§2, is amended to read:

6 The Except as provided in subsection 1-A, the effect of
8 noise from a development may be regulated pursuant to section
484, subsection 3.

10 Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §482-A, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

12 1-A. Exception. The effect of noise from construction of
14 residential housing developments is exempt from review and
regulation under this article.

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This bill exempts residential housing developments from
22 noise control rules during construction under the site location
of development laws.
