An Act Regarding Growth Management Efforts in Opportunity Zones.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4344, sub-§1, ¶¶A and B, as enacted by PL
4	1989, c. 104, Pt. A, $\S45$ and Pt. C, $\$10$ , are amended to read:
6	A. Scheduled comprehensive plan development under section 4343, subsection 1; and
