HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1512, L.D. 2092, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Travel Information Advisory Council"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Membership. The Travel Information Advisory Council is composed of the following members.

A. The Governor shall appoint:

- (1) One representative of the lodging industry;
- (2) One representative of the restaurant industry;
- (3) One representative of garden clubs;
- (4) One representative of agriculture;
- (5) One representative of the recreation industry;
- (6) One representative of environmental organizations;
- (7) One representative of nonprofit historical and cultural institutions;
- (8) One representative of sign designers and fabrication artisans; and
- (9) One representative of the general public.

These members are appointed to 2-year terms of office expiring on January 16th, with the terms of those members appointed under subparagraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) expiring

2 in odd-numbered years and the terms of those members
3 appointed under subparagraphs (5), (6), (7), (8) and (9)
4 expiring in even-numbered years.

6 B. The council has 2 legislative members until the
7 adjournment of the First Regular Session of the 115th
8 Legislature, to be appointed as follows:

10 (1) One Senator appointed by the President of the
11 Senate to a term concurrent with the term to which the
12 Senator is elected; and


14 (2) One member of the House of Representatives
15 appointed by the Speaker of the House of
16 Representatives to a term concurrent with the term to
17 which the member of the House of Representatives is
18 elected;

20 If a vacancy occurs prior to the expiration of a term of any
21 member, including legislative members, that vacancy must be
22 filled by the appointing authority as provided in this subsection
23 for the remainder of that term.'

30 This amendment corrects the format of a subsection of the
31 Maine Revised Statutes.
