HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1512, L.D. 2092, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Travel Information Advisory Council"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Membership. The Travel Information Advisory Council is composed of the following 11 members.

A. The Governor shall appoint:

- (1) One representative of the lodging industry;
- (2) One representative of the restaurant industry;
- (3) One representative of garden clubs;
- (4) One representative of agriculture;
- (5) One representative of the recreation industry;
- (6) One representative of environmental organizations;
- (7) One representative of nonprofit historical and cultural institutions;
- (8) One representative of sign designers and fabrication artisans; and
- (9) One representative of the general public.

These members are appointed to 2-year terms of office expiring on January 16th, with the terms of those members appointed under subparagraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) expiring in odd-numbered years and the terms of those members appointed under subparagraphs (5), (6), (7), (8) and (9) expiring in even-numbered years.
