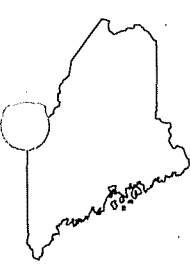

**An Act to Allow the Issuance of a Temporary License in Case of the
Death of a Real Estate Broker.**



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 32 MRSA §13003-A is enacted to read:

6 13003-A. Temporary license in case of death

8 Upon proper application and payment of fee, the Real Estate
10 Commission may issue, without written examination, a temporary
12 real estate broker license in the event of the death of a real
14 estate broker. The license term may not exceed 6 months from the
16 date of death and may be issued to the deceased broker's personal
18 representative or a person appointed by the personal
20 representative and approved by the commission.

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill allows the issuance of a 6-month temporary license
20 to the legal representative of a deceased real estate broker or
to the representative's designee.
