HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1533, L.D. 2118, Bill, "An Act Regarding Municipal Shellfish Regulations"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sec. 1."

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 7 by inserting at the end a new sentence to read: 'This subsection is effective July 1, 1990.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the section of the committee amendment that repeals the 10% tolerance for clams less than the 2-inch minimum size. The amendment also makes the provision requiring the use of identification tags by clam diggers effective July 1, 1990, allowing the Department of Marine Resources time for rulemaking.
