SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1533, L.D. 2118, Bill, "An Act Regarding Municipal Shellfish Regulations"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 2, line 14 in the amendment) by striking out the following: "July 1, 1990" and inserting in its place the following: '91 days following adjournment of the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency clause.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the committee amendment and delays repeal of the 10% tolerance for clams less than the 2-inch minimum size until 91 days after the adjournment of the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature.
