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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1546, L.D. 2131

The original bill struck out the provision that the functions of the Maine Committee on Aging are solely advisory.
 This amendment retains that provision.

- 6 2. The amendment adds staff and volunteers to those individuals connected with the committee who must abide by the 8 federal law regarding conflict of interest as required by the original bill.
- 3. The amendment requires that the Director of the Bureau 12 of Elder and Adult Services act as liaison between that bureau and the committee.
- 4. The amendment adds to the reports required from the
  16 committee those requested by the Governor or the Legislature and
  requires that the committee's long-term care ombudsman program
  18 submit reports as required by the bureau.
