An Act to Change the Name of the Committee for the Interdepartmental Coordination of Services to Children and Families.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 34-B MRSA §1214, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 4 502, Pt. B, §44, is amended to read: 6 §1214. Interdepartmental Council 8 1. Establishment. The Committee-for-the Interdepartmental Coordination-of-Services-to-Children-and-Families Council is 10 established. It is the intent of the Legislature to 12 2. Purpose. encourage the coordination of policies and programs for Maine 14 children and families. 16 The committee council shall be composed of З. Membership. The Commissioner of Corrections; Commissioner of 4 <u>5</u> members: 18 Educational Cultural Services; Commissioner of Human and Services; and Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental 20 Retardation; and Director of the Division of Community Services. 22 Goals of the council. The goals of the committee 4. council shall be: 24 To encourage a statewide system of coordinated services, Α. which are responsive to the current needs of children and 26 families and which are delivered by a partnership of public, 28 private and nonprofit state level and community based agencies, and to promote access to services by all children 30 and their families who are in need of these services; 32 в. To evaluate on a continuing basis the allocation of resources to ensure the availability of quality services delivered in a coordinated and efficient manner that is 34 consistent with the needs of children and families; and 36 C. To continue the development of a comprehensive and 38 coordinated approach to initiation and revision of policy affecting services to children and families. 40 The committee council shall meet on a regular 5. Meetings. 42 basis. 44 The committee council shall select a chair from 6. Chair. among the-4-commissioners its members and the chair shall serve for a term established by the committee council. 46 48 7. Subcommittees. The eemmittee <u>council</u> may appoint subcommittees to carry out its work. Subcommittee membership may 50 include representatives of public and private agencies which serve youth and families and other persons with special knowledge

of, responsibility for or interest in an area related to the goals of the committee council.

8. Report. The committee council shall report annually to the Legislature on its progress in meeting the goals cited in subsection 4 and its proposals for implementing these same goals in the forthcoming year.

9. Administration. The costs associated with the eemmittee
10 <u>council</u> shall be shared among the members of the eemmittee <u>council</u>. Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a
12 member department <u>or division</u> from assigning its employees to serve as staff to the eemmittee <u>council</u>. The Department of
14 Mental Health and Mental Retardation shall serve as fiscal agent for the eemmittee <u>council</u>.

10. Authorization to accept funds. The Department of
 Mental Health and Mental Retardation may accept, on behalf of the
 eemmittee council, funds from the Federal Government, from any
 political subdivision of the State or from any individual,
 foundation or corporation and may expend these funds for purposes
 which are consistent with this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

28 This bill changes the name of the Committee for the Interdepartmental Coordination of Services to Children and 30 Families to the Interdepartmental Council and adds the Director of the Division of Community Services to the membership. The 32 Interdepartmental Council is the common name for this committee and is consistent with other statutes.
