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28	5. Treasurer of State. An amount equal to 5.1% of the receipts from the taxes imposed under Title 36, Parts 3 and 8, and credited to the General Fund, plus an amount equal to
30	\$237,000 <u>\$1,070,000</u> of the receipts from the tax <u>taxes</u> imposed under Title 36, Part <u>Parts</u> 3 and 8, shall must be transferred by
