HOUSE AMENDMENT "House to S.P. 843, L.D. 2162

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the exemption from surcharge on personal insurance rates for law enforcement officers for accidents which occur in the course of employment applies when another insurance policy provides coverage for the accident. The amendment adds a similar clarification for public works employees.
